Flu Vaccination Clinics

Flu clinics are now available for eligible patients. This year there are three different vaccines. We are running separate clinics for each: 65s and over, under 65s and children aged 2-3.

From 1st October, we will also be able to offer you on the day urgent clinic appointments and a doctor telephone triage service.

This will mean you will no longer wait for a GP to finish clinic to call you back. Nor will you have to sit and wait in our 'extras' clinic. Instead you will be given a timed appointment at one of our local clinics.
